



Brexit update



As the UK continues to negotiate its mechanism for departure from the EU we want to provide you with reassurance about our preparations for Brexit.

We've been working closely with our legal teams in the UK and Europe to understand the ramifications that Brexit will have on our services to our clients. We can confirm that we are well prepared to adjust to the legal consequences of either a 'deal' or 'no-deal' Brexit. Our primary focus is to continue to meet our customers' needs regardless of the outcome and ensure all colleagues are well supported if any changes are necessary.

Firstly, we would like to make clear that it will be business as usual in most situations, whether there is a negotiated withdrawal or a 'no deal' Brexit. Where the provision of our services is affected, we anticipate that there will need to be some small changes to contracts.

The vast majority of our operations will not be impacted by these changes and the few teams who are likely to be affected will be fully briefed and provided with full training to ensure they understand the new working requirements needed. Wherever possible, we will ensure that changes are system-based with minimal impact on our day-to-day activities.

As we all get greater clarity in the next few days and weeks, we will be in touch with clients who we understand could be directly affected to discuss any change of process.
