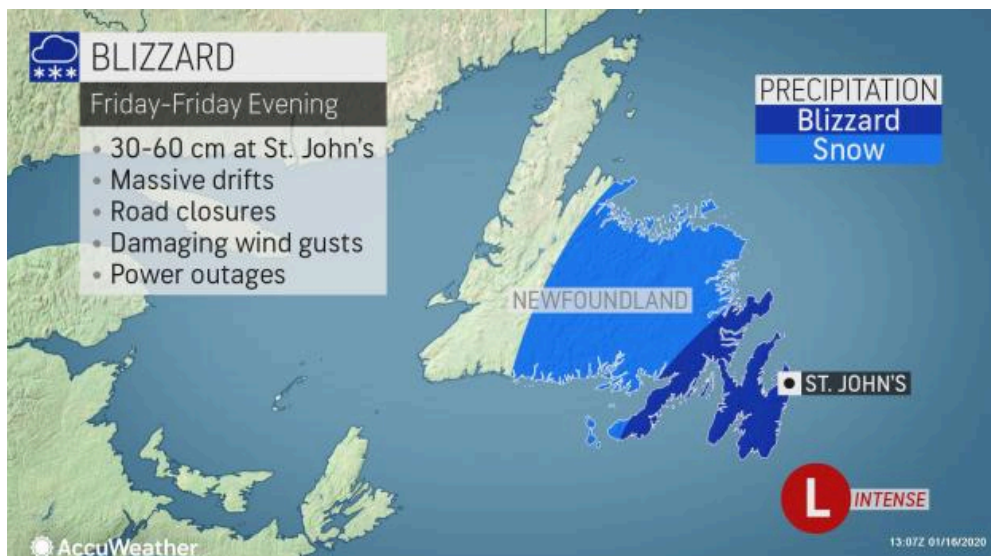


# Bomb cyclone hits Newfoundland

January 21, 2020

A state of emergency remains in effect for St. John's Newfoundland after a bomb cyclone hit the area Friday, causing 76 centimeters of snow to bury the city and surrounding areas. This is the first state of emergency announced in more than 35 years. Businesses and streets remain closed, and military assistance has been deployed to the hardest hit areas.
