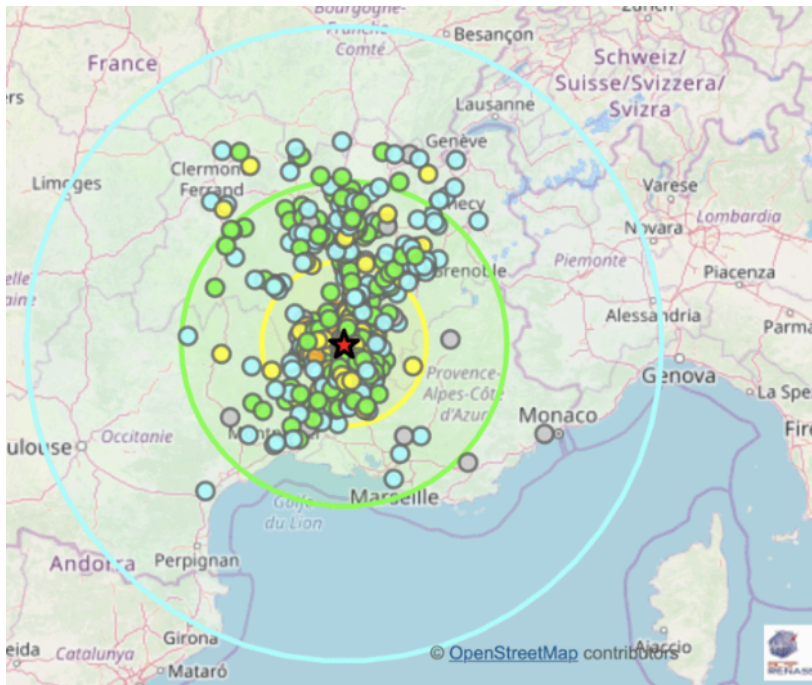

Strong earthquake hits Southern France

Following the 5.4 magnitude earthquake that hit near Montelimar in the Drôme on Monday, November 11, 2019 at 10:52, the Sedgwick France teams were mobilised. The first findings on-site reveal that buildings have generally suffered damage of average intensity. However, we note areas of higher intensities in some parts of Southern France.
